Pathways to Sustainable Futures (PASF) focuses on sharing achievements, innovations and challenges of urban, environmental and transportation planning in the Netherlands. Learn about:

- compact city policies – almost no sprawl
- sustainable transportation – 27% of all trips by bicycle – how is that possible?
- adaptations to challenges of climate change, including water management
- high environmental standards
- affordable high-quality social housing
- integrated and interactive decision-making



Pathways to Sustainable Futures (PASF) is a summer/winter school consisting of two parts:

1. **Yogyakarta (UGM, Indonesia)**, 7-11 January 2019
2. **Groningen (The Netherlands)**, 16-29 January 2019

Both parts can be attended separately. There is no admission fee for the first part, in Yogyakarta, for students enrolled at an Indonesian university.
